Albi - 18th and 19th October 2025

Pre-registration request for the 'OPEN' competition

- Conditions -

Around 400 male and female athletes selected by IAU member federations will take part in the 24-hours World Championships.

The IAU and the French Athletics Federation (FFA), have approved our request for the participation of approximately 40 athletes in the 'OPEN' race.

The number of entries for the 'OPEN' competition will be directly linked to the number of athletes entered by the federations. 'OPEN' entries will only be validated after the 1^{st} of September 2025, the closing date for federations' final entries.

A waiting list will be drawn up according to the date on which the application is sent and the performances achieved in 2023 and 2024 in officially measured 24-hours competitions.

Minimum performances for pre-registration

Men 200 km and Women 180 km

To register on the waiting list, please complete and return the 'pre-registration request' form. Payment will be made only at the time of final registration.

French athletes must be licensed with the FFA and foreign athletes must submit the P.P.S. at the time of registration - website $\underline{\text{https://pps.athle.fr/}}$.

Registration fee 120 €. The closing meal is included in the registration fee for the athlete. Meals for accompanying persons will be proposed on reservation at the time of registration.

Of course, we know how difficult it is to plan your training for such a competition without the certainty of being able to take part, but the 'OPEN' competition is an exemption that we have obtained from the IAU.

In order to anticipate travel and reduce costs, we will transmit decisions as early as possible, depending on the date of application and selection criteria.
